22-090 Leapfrog. One fellow leaps over the other one, hits a lever that drops your coin into the tree. (Original produced 1891.) 7½" long.



22-310 Uncle Remus. Press head of the chicken, and watch Uncle Remus dart into his shack with your penny. 5½" long.



22-150 Punch & Judy. Punch takes a whack at Judy, and she deposits the penny. (Original produced 1882.) 7½" high.



22-220 Cabin. Pull the whitewash brush on this trapper's cabin. He'll somersault and kick your penny through the roof. (Original produced 1885.) 4¾" long.



22-110 Organ. Turn the crank. Children dance, bells chime, and monkey tips his hat while dropping penny into bank. (Original produced 1882.) 7½" high.
