

## DESIGN FOR A TOY SAFE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 5,494, dated January 23, 1872.

Specification describing a Design for a Toy and distinctive character of my design is the Safe, invented by Anthony M. Smith, of application of the door to a toy safe, in combi-Brooklyn city, in the county of Kings and State of New York.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of my "toy

safe," which is provided with a door, D.

N is a niche. W is the figure of a watchman standing in the niche.

I am aware that large business safes provided with doors hinged to the front side thereof are in common use; therefore the novelty nation with the niche and figure of a watchman, as shown in the drawing forming part of this application.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design of a "toy safe" in which the front is composed of a door, niche, and figure of a watchman, substantially as shown and described.
