




COMBINED TOY BANK AND MUSIC BOX

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Theodore P. Heider, a citizen of the United States, residing in East Orange, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Toy Bank and Music Box, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, and in which:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of the combined toy bank and music box embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, and Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

The back of the design is plain and unornamented.
