DESIGN FOR A TOY.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,489, dated July 31, 1888.

Application filed July 2, 1888. Serial No. 278,862. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DANIEL COOKE, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Camden, New Jersey, have invented a new 5 and original Design for a Toy, of which the following is a specification.

My design for a toy is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, which represents a

front view of the toy.

The prominent characteristic of the toy is the representation of the conventional figure of a clown holding a ring or hoop, other features of the design being the representation of an animal and a barrel or like receptacle, the

whole being arranged, as shown, upon a suit- 15 able base.

I claim-

The design for a toy, said design comprising the representation of an animal, a barrel or like receptacle, and a clown holding a ring or 20 hoop, all substantially as described and shown.
