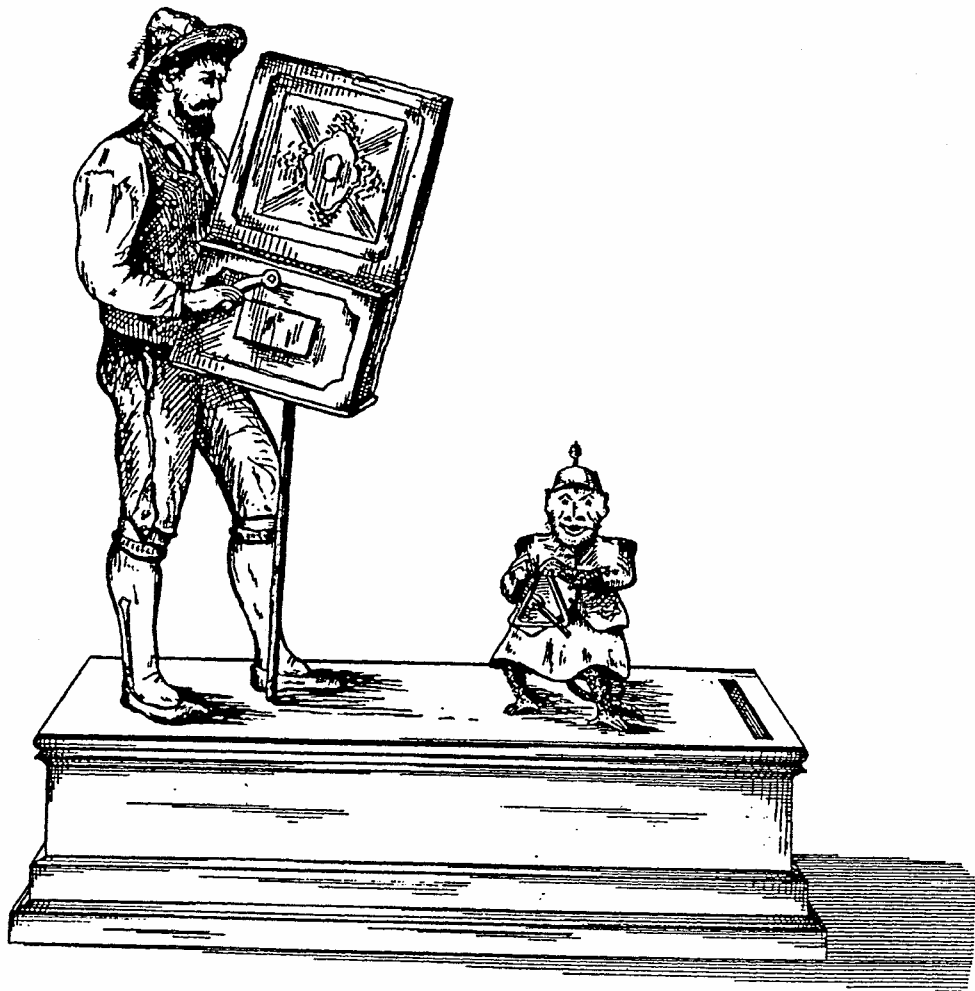

DESIGN FOR A TOY MONEY-BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 20,794, dated June 2, 1891.

Application filed May 6, 1891. Serial No. 391,823. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DANIEL COOKE, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Camden, Camden county, New Jersey, have
5 invented a Design for a Toy Money-Bank, of which the following is a specification.

My design for a toy savings-bank is fully illustrated in the accompanying drawing, the figure of which is a face view of my improved
10 bank.

The general feature of the design is an organ-grinder and his attendant. On the base is mounted the miniature representation of an organ-grinder in the act of playing the organ, his hand grasping the handle of the organ.
15 At one side of the organ-grinder is rep-

resented in the present instance a monkey playing upon an instrument, although this figure may be changed without departing from my invention. 20
