

DESIGN FOR A TOY SAVINGS-BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 27,565, dated August 24, 1897.

Application filed July 10, 1897. Serial No. 644,147. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, PETER ADAMS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Buffalo, in the county of Erie and State of New York, have 5 invented and produced a new and original Design for a Toy Savings-Bank, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The design relates to the general form or configuration of an ornamental toy savings-bank, as represented in the accompanying drawing, which shows a perspective view of a toy savings-bank containing my design.

The leading feature of said design consists of a grotesque figure representing a pig or

hog, with an open mouth, seated in a miniature high chair, and a tray arranged in front of said figure.

A represents the grotesque figure, and B 20 the chair. C is the tray, arranged in front of said figure and connected therewith by the pivoted arms or legs d.

What I claim as my invention is— The design for a toy savings-bank herein 25 shown and described.
