DESIGN FOR A TOY BANK.

Application filed September 25, 1925. Serial No. 14,903. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DOUGLAS HALL, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of Chicago, county of Cook, and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Toy Banks, of which the following is a specification, reference being had the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
